Notice to Exhibitors

- **Entries for a maximum of ten (10) dogs entered in agility are allowed in each envelope submitted to the Event Secretary.** Envelopes containing entries for more than the ten (10) dog maximum shall be treated as an invalid entry and shall be returned to sender.
- You may include a copy of your dog's official **jump height card** with your entry. If a copy is not included you will be required to present your card at check-in or have your dog measured by the judge. Dogs which jump at the 24" height will only be measured if there is an AKC Field Representative or a Volunteer Measuring Official (VMO) present.
- The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this event, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.
- Entry fees will be refunded, less \$5.00 per day, for bitches that come in season after the closing date, provided the Event Secretary is notified, **in writing**, at least thirty (30) minutes prior to the start of classes each day.
- Any and all refund checks will be mailed by the BCSA Treasurer after the specialty.
- Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the Event Committee.
- It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Event Committee, be asked to leave the show site.
