Trial Closing Date: June 11, 2008 at 6:00 PM or when entry limits are reached (but not sooner than the Random Draw date). If entry limits are not reached during the opening period, they will be filled on a "first received" basis until the closing date.

All entries will be opened prior to the draw and checked for accuracy. Duplicate entries for the same dog will be returned. Entries for a maximum of ten (10) dogs are allowed in each envelope submitted for the Random Draw. Envelopes containing entries for more than 10 dogs shall be treated as an invalid entry and will be returned.

In the event an envelope is drawn that contains entries that would exceed the entry limit; there will be a Random Draw of the individual entries contained therein to fill the specified entry limit. If necessary, a draw for an alternate's list will be held from the remaining entries after limits have been reached.

ACCEPTANCE & CONFIRMATION OF ENTRIES

Confirmation Letters will be sent out as soon as possible after closing of the trial. For faster acknowledgement of acceptance please include a self-addressed stamped postcard with your entry form for the trial secretary to return, or include your e-mail address on your entry form. Please only include email address if it is a valid address and you check email on a regular basis.

DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

This trial is open to all dogs over the age of 15 months that are registered with the American Kennel Club, or have an AKC limited registration, or are of a registerable breed that has obtained an ILP number from AKC, except bitches in season, aggressive dogs, blind or deaf dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance.

Breeds not registerable with the AKC are NOT eligible to enter. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline Rules for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate.

RIBBONS AND PRIZES

CLASS DESCRIPTIONS

Please see the AKC Regulations for Agility Trials for current class descriptions. Dogs must be entered only in Regular Classes or Preferred Classes with no cross-over between them allowed at the same set of trials.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

- The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.
- **Dogs under the age of 6 months are not permitted on the show grounds of AKC Agility Trials.**
- Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that the dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by the action of the show committee. No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, and act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- Refund of entry fees, less \$5.00 per day administrative fee, will be made for bitches in season upon receipt of letter written by a veterinarian prior to that day's event.
- Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. There will be a \$20.00 service charge for returned checks.
- It is expressly understood that the exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Show Committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any entry fees paid will be made.
- Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run.
- **Dogs must be on leash AT ALL TIMES except when in the ring or when in designated agility jump warm-up areas. This will be strictly enforced.**
- **Overnight parking or camping is not permitted on show site grounds.**
- Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.
- **Your help is requested in order to preserve our ability to use our trial site, as well as our motel facilities. We ask for your cooperation in cleaning up after your dogs. Small plastic bags will be provided at the trial site for dog waste pickup. Thank you for your help.**
- The Regulations for Agility Trials are available from the AKC at 5580 Centerview Drive, Raleigh, NC 27606 , or www.akc.org.

- Qualifying Ribbons will be awarded for each qualifying score earned.
- Standard Agility and Jumpers with Weaves: Placement rosettes will be awarded for 1st through 4th place in each jump height and in each division.
- Preferred Agility and Jumpers with Weaves: Placement rosettes will be awarded for 1st through 4th place in each jump height and in each division.
- A dog toy (valued at up to \$2.00) will be awarded for 1st place in each class
- A MACH bar and Champion rosette will be awarded to anyone earning a MACH or PAX title.

OBSTACLES

Please see the AKC Regulations for Agility Trials for current list of Mandatory Obstacles. Obstacles will meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of the Regulations for Agility Trials.

COURSE FAMILIARIZATION

Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, prior to the start of their class. All walk-throughs are restricted to the handlers entered in that class. **There will be NO contact familiarization for Novice dogs at these trials.**

MEASURING

All dogs competing in Agility will be required to present an official Jump Height Card prior to running in an Agility Trial. All dogs except those jumping 24" or 26"(unless a VMO or AKC Representative is present) without permanent or temporary jump height cards will be measured. **If you have a jump height card, BCSA will accept photocopies of the permanent height card or unexpired temporary height card with your entry for this show.**

From I-94 (heading West)

Take the Zeeb Road exit and head North.

You will cross the Huron River and then some RR tracks. At the stop sign turn left onto Huron River Drive. You will pass Dexter-Huron Metropark on your left. Approximately 1.5 miles down the road you will make a right turn onto the cross drive connecting us to Joy Road. The building at the corner is the Dexter Research Center (7300). There is a also a sign for "Dexter Martial Arts". We are the large building up the drive.

From I-94 (heading East):

Take the Baker Road exit and head North.

Stay on Baker Rd. until it ends in downtown Dexter). Turn left onto Ann Arbor St. and take the immediate right onto Central St.. You have to go around 'Monument Park'. Stay on Central and cross the Huron River. There is a party store on the corner where Huron River Drive and Mast Road intersect. You can either turn onto Huron River Drive and take the second driveway on the left (just past 7300 - Dexter Research Center) or you can turn right onto Joy Rd. and go approximately 1/4 mile until you see a sign for "Dexter Martial Arts". Turn right onto that drive and we are the building immediately on your right. Come around to the back.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. The Judge's measurement will be valid for this trial *or back-to-back trials* only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.
